

Secondly, we do choose the direction our life is headed. Several times in Scripture the statement is made that "the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom." Does a reverent respect and awe of God impact each decision we make? Are we running to God or away from Him? Are we focused on the temporal or eternal? #### "Wisdom"

"If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given him." (James 1:5 NIV)

A definition for wisdom which I learned about forty years ago was found in a paraphrase version of the Bible in the book of Proverbs and it said, "Wisdom is knowing and doing what is right." It would be nice if every decision we had to make was clear-cut with no doubt about what is right or wrong; however, in a high percentage of life's decisions it is not immediately obvious whether they are "right" or "wrong". For instance, if I have 30 minutes free, should I rest, read, call a friend, start another project, run an errand, pray, weed the garden, or something else. What is the right thing to do? This is "life"! Life is a series of decisions moment by moment every day. How can I be wise in all these big and little decisions which I make each day?

I find myself struggling right now in more than one situation, wondering what I should do. What level of commitment and involvement does the Lord really desire of me? Undoubtedly, every day all of you face similar decisions. We are very much aware that we are living in a sinful and evil world. How does one truly demonstrate wisdom in his or her walk with the Lord when surrounded by brokenness and ungodliness?

I would like to suggest a couple responses which, based on the teaching of Scripture, seem wise when facing the many decisions of life:

First, we must continually rest in the Lord, trusting in His wisdom and faithfulness. This summer in the Sunday morning adult Sunday School class, we studied the book of Job. One truth clearly taught was that we surely cannot know the reasoning and thoughts of our sovereign, all-knowing God. Therefore, the wise person submits to Him and trusts in his grace and mercy no matter what the situation we find ourselves in. We must rely on God's promise to faithfully guide and direct our paths as we trust in Him (Prov. 3:5-6).
