It's a physical time change in history that has enough power to motivate people to live differently, to think differently, to believe differently.

With every new, there is an old. Old memories. Old habits. Old thought patterns. Old belief systems. Old feelings. Old baggage. Old ways of living life. That's why the new is so great for us, because we know intimately the old ways and we are longing for a tangible time in our crazy lives that everyone comes together and celebrates, is motivated by and believes in the newness of the year.
