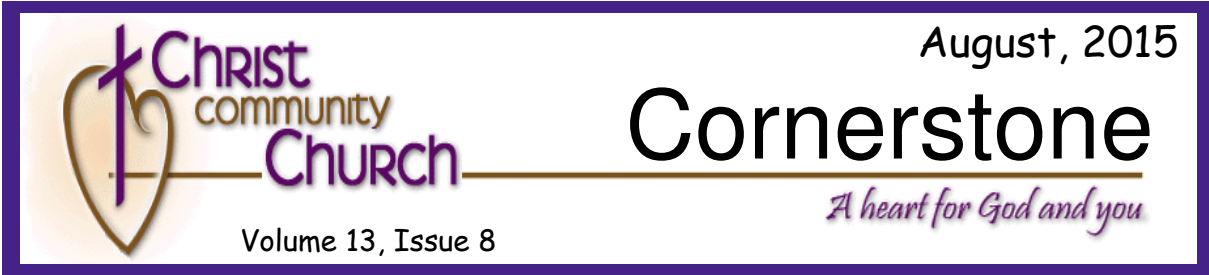

“Could God be Speaking to Us - Like to Ezekiel?”

This morning as I began reading the 2nd chapter of Ezekiel, the thought that was impressed upon me was: This could just as well be God’s message to the church in America today or a message to each one of us as His children who live in an increasingly defiant society.

In verse 1 the Lord said to Ezekiel, “Stand up on your feet and I will speak to you.” Is God telling us to “stand up” and listen? The passage goes on say, “As he (God’s messenger) spoke, the Spirit came into me and raised me to my feet, and I heard him speaking to me.”

As God’s children, we placed our faith in Christ, the Spirit of God took up residence in our lives; however, do we need a fresh filling of the Spirit such that we allow Him to raise us to our fee and hear God speaking to us through the Spirit?

God called Ezekiel to bring a message to the Israelites. Similarly, as a child of God, and collectively as a church, is God saying to us, “I am sending you to the Americans, to rebellious nation that has rebelled against me; they and their fathers have been in a revolt against me to this very day? The people to whom I am sending you are obstinate and stubborn.”

The message to Ezekiel has only nine verses; they tell of God’s calling of Ezekiel to be a prophet for Him. I’d encourage you to read these few verses and prayerfully consider; Is God in a similar manner calling us and His church to be prophets to America - a rebellious and stubborn people?
