“When You’re Called by the Wrong Name”

Vanellope von Schweetz knew that she was something special. She knew she was born to race. She believed in her heart that she was destined for the top of the leaderboard. But to everyone else, she was not known as a great racer. She wasn’t seen as a worthy opponent. Instead, she was known as...a glitch. All the other racers called her glitch. Even King Candy led the charge in making sure she knew she was a nobody. But Vanellope didn’t believe she was a glitch. She saw something in herself that no one else was able to see.

While this is merely one of the story lines from Wreck-It Ralph, I find myself in the same race car as Vanellope. I hear the voices of those around me telling me everything I am not. I hear the chants of unworthy and unable and unqualified. And then I realize that those voices aren’t coming from without, but rather from within. They are the voices in my own head telling me that I am a glitch. I hear, “You’re too flawed.” “You’re too broken.” “You’re too faulty.” I hear, “You’ll never amount to anything and those around you are better off with someone smarter, wiser, better.”

My adversary, the accuser of the brethren, reminds me every day who I am. And he’s right. I am all of those things. I am faulty. I am broken. I am unworthy. I am a glitch. But the truth is, I don’t go by that name any longer. And he can keep calling me by that name, but I refuse to answer. Why? Because that is not my name. I have a new name, given to me by my Father.

When we are called by the wrong name, we need to remember that the One who is in us is greater than he who is in the world (1 John 4:4). Satan may want to convince us that we are defeated, but we know that there is no condemnation for those in Christ (Romans 8:1). When we begin to think we are a nobody, remember the Father has called us His children (1 John 3:1). We have a name chosen in grace and love. And when you are tempted to

forget, or you think that wrong name is somehow correct, remember this: The world can call you a glitch, but the Father has created you for greatness.

In the end, Vanellope crosses the finish line, restoring her memory and status as Princess Vanellope, the game’s ruler and lead character, while keeping her advantageous glitching ability. What a powerful reminder. What Satan reminds you is your weakness, God has the power to use for His glory. Your glitch just may end up being what makes you great.
